Implementation of system integration at HELA in 2023; Heras Cloture Production and IMP will follow later.

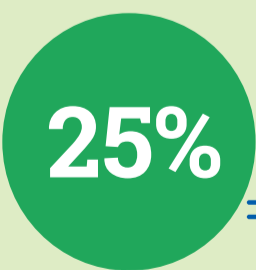


10% of the processes within the Netherlands is circular.
